- Coast routes with Sungai Lembing, Kuantan, Pahang
- Rural road areas, Sabah and Sarawak
- Batu Dam, Kampung Pusu and the Hulu Gombak Forest Reserve with its water catchment areas, Kuala Lumpur
- Sungai Dua site near Karak, Pahang
