Once complete, all three of Malaysia's Els Club destinations will play an integral role in increasing the number of inbound golf travellers to the peninsula, as is the vision of Destination Resorts and Hotels Sdn Bhd (DRH), the companycharged with growing the nation's golf tourism offering.
